Considerations

Students considering applying should be aware of the following requirements:

Attend a 1-hour orientation one week prior to the event

Commit to all four days of the internship

Sign all forms and submit no later than May 18th (e.g. photo release, HIPAA, etc)

Background checks will be conducted on those accepted into the internship

Provide own transportation to and from each location
